Footnotes

BUDS PAL had speed outside a rival then stalked that one off the rail, re-bid alongside that foe on the turn, took the lead a quarter mile out, inched away under urging into the stretch, kicked clear and held. SMOKEN LEGACY settled a bit off the rail to the stretch, came out in midstretch and rallied late for second three deep on the line. OMAR stalked the pace off the inside, came out into the stretch, was three wide in midstretch and was edged late for second between foes on the wire. WILLIE BROWN saved ground chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch, split horses in midstretch and was edged for the show. FIST PUMP chased off the rail then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. WOLFGANG (IRE) settled outside chasing the pace, went between foes leaving the backstretch and on the turn, split horses past the eighth pole and could not offer the necessary response. IMFIXINTOWIN was in a good position chasing the pace outside then three wide on the turn, dropped back off the rail and weakened. GAL HAS TO LIKE IT had good early speed inside the winner, inched away on the backstretch, dueled along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
