WILL TRUE UP squeezed back just after the start, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up nearing the wire. GRAND GIANT stalked inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside a rival in midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and just failed to hold off the winner. WIND OF BOSPHORUS dueled a bit off the rail on the backstretch, inched away on the turn, angled in leaving the bend, fought back inside through the final furlong and held third. COSMIC HEAT saved ground stalking the pace, moved up on the turn and into the stretch, came off the fence past midstretch, was between foes late and edged for the show. STAR DESTINY had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, stalked just off the

rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. THUNDER'S ROLLIN' a bit slow to begin, pulled his way between horses on the backstretch and steadied past the half mile pole, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DEMOCRAT DUCK broke a bit slowly and steadied, went up between horses then chased a bit off the rail, angled to the inside in the stretch and improved position. RAVEN'S HONOR had good early speed then stalked between horses to the stretch and weakened. SAY OW chased outside then three deep, angled in alongside a rival leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch and did not rally. RADER THE RAT dropped back outside then chased four wide, angled in leaving the turn and lacked a rally. HUME broke in, had early speed outside then stalked four wide, continued three deep on the turn and four wide again into the stretch and weakened. DERRINGER had speed between foes then stalked between rivals, was shuffled back a half mile out, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
