CHOSEN MIRACLE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the backstretch, responded when challenged again on the second turn, edged clear into the stretch and held on gamely under urging and a strong hand ride. CALIMONCO stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and finished willingly. WILLYCONKER (IRE) settled off the rail then a bit off the fence on the backstretch and second turn, came out leaving that turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. KEY DECISION (ARG) close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally but lost third late. AKKADIAN chased between horses then off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and weakened. OLIGARCH three deep into the first turn, prompted the pace outside the winner then stalked off the rail, bid alongside that one again on the second turn, dropped back between horses into the stretch and also weakened. JEBRICA chased three wide then outside a rival into the second turn, dropped back off the inside, angled in entering the stretch and gave way.
