Footnotes

THIS MEANS WAR saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, took the lead alongside the pacesetter in midstretch and won clear under some urging and good handling. MADRE LUNA angled in and settled off the pace inside, saved ground on the turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied for the place. POSSIBLE (GB) pulled her way along to chase the pace outside a rival then a bit off the rail into the stretch, moved up inside then came out in deep stretch and went around the pacesetter late for the show. BACKWOODS BELLE pulled a bit under a tight hold but sped to a clear early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail in midstretch, was not a match for the top pair late and just lost third. J LOUIE stalked outside a rival then three deep leaving the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HLAO ROO settled outside then alongside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. BRIGHT TOWN saved ground stalking the pace, was between horses a quarter mile out and weakened in the stretch.
