Footnotes

DEACON SPEAKIN' settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead four wide past midstretch and held on gamely under some urging and good handling. EUROGLIDE chased inside, inched forward leaving the second turn, lacked room off heels from upper to midstretch, split horses past the eighth pole, bid inside and continued willingly. MAYBE TUESDAY saved ground chasing the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch, waited momentarily then bid between horses in midstretch and continued gamely between foes through the final furlong. SEATTLE RULER sent between horses early then stalked a bit off the rail or inside, came out into the stretch, re-bid between rivals to put a head in front in midstretch, fought back between foes in the last furlong and was outfinished late. WARRENS WILD THING angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. MOMENT OF WEAKNESS (IRE) fanned four wide into the first turn, prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside a rival, re-bid three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, steadied in tight between horses nearing the eighth pole and weakened. LORD'S MINISTER sent along early then pulled his way along off the rail into the first turn, angled in and dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, fought back on the second turn and to midstretch, then weakened.
