STREET CHOIR chased a bit off the rail, split horses then angled in on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and rallied under some urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. WONDERFUL UNION broke out but on top, sped to a clear early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, remained clear past midstretch, could not hold off the winner but saved the place. AWESOME PROSPECT off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and gained the show late. GENTLEMEN PETE stalked three deep on the backstretch, angled in a bit off the rail on the turn, split rivals in deep stretch and lacked the needed response. ADAMOR was in a good position tracking the winner along the inside to the stretch, continued on the rail and did not rally. WISTFULLEE MINE chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. MIKEY T hopped then bobbed in a slow start, chased three deep, continued outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
