ZUBOFF had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away into the stretch and drew clear under some urging and strong handling. CANDY WALTZ bobbed at the start, went up three deep then chased off the rail, went around a rival on the turn, came out some in the stretch and was clearly second best. PRIDE OF SILVER between horses early, settled outside a rival or off the rail, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. KENICHI prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, battled outside the winner midway on the bend, dropped back in the stretch and weakened. LAST MEMORIES saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. UNUSUAL MYSTERY broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out in midstretch and was not a threat. IMFIXINTOWIN tugged his way along to duel between horses, was shuffled back some on the turn, angled inward in the stretch and had little left for the drive.
