ATTICLUDE chased between horses to the stretch, angled in some in midstretch, rallied under urging between foes to gain the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. STARS AND MOONS was in a good position chasing the leaders three deep to the stretch, rallied outside in late stretch to gain the place four wide on the wire. CONGREGATIONALIST had good early speed and angled in, dueled outside a rival, came out some in midstretch and came back on between horses late. WHIPSTOCK pulled between horses and steadied in tight early, moved up four wide on the backstretch, bid three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, battled outside a rival in the drive and continued willingly between foes late. DOUBLEDOWN ON TEN went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and through the stretch and was outfinished. SAN SAVINO saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in the drive and lacked a further response.
