PRIZED BY BUCK stalked between horses, dropped back on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied under urging and energetic handling to get up late. BULL TIME shuffled back early, chased between horses on the backstretch, split rivals on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched away but could not hold off the winner. IMPROVISO settled off the rail, moved up four wide on the turn and into the stretch and outfinished rivals for third. GREEN TEAM had speed between horses then dueled off the rail, angled in on the turn, inched away nearing midstretch, fought back past the eighth pole then weakened. BANDINI'S ROGUE broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and improved position. WILD SIDE STORY prompted the pace inside then stalked along the rail on the backstretch and turn, loomed a threat inside in midstretch but weakened some in the final furlong. RYE WHISKEY dueled four wide then outside a rival, battled alongside that one on the turn but weakened in the drive. QUICK CENIZAS had speed between rivals then stalked between foes, dropped back on the turn and also weakened. DYNAGAIN saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and lacked a response in the drive. STORMIN ARVIN bobbed at the start, chased outside, went up four wide on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. HARRY S. stalked outside then three wide, continued between foes on the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. STANLEY'S FLYER a bit slow to begin, chased between horses, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the drive. DEMAND SUCCESS chased between horses then outside a rival, split foes again on the turn, angled in leaving the bend and was not a threat.
