MONEY TALKER saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid four wide past the eighth pole, gained the lead and won clear under urging. TE RAPA chased three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, bid between horses past the eighth pole and edged rivals for the place. SWIFT EAGLE had speed outside foes then inched away and angled in, set the pace along the rail, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner but held third. ROCK THIS WAY stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival in the stretch then between horses past midstretch and was outfinished for a minor award. ROBBIE'S WAR between foes early, stalked inside, awaited room when trapped along the rail in midstretch, came out and lacked the needed rally. PORFIDO (CHI) saved ground off the pace to the stretch, came out in midstretch and found his best stride late. TAKE A YARD settled inside without early speed, swung out into the stretch and did not rally. BUD I CRUSHED IT stalked outside a rival then off the rail, dropped back between foes into the second turn and weakened. HOLLYWOOD FIERCE hesitated to be away slowly, tugged his way along outside a rival when well back, was pulled up into the second turn when bleeding from the nostrils and was vanned off.
