Footnotes

STACY'S HOPE settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. STREETS OF HEAVEN chased off the rail then outside a foe on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the lead alongside a rival past the eighth pole, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but was clearly second best. MAX COOPER dueled three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, battled outside a rival midway on the bend, inched away into the stretch, drifted out a bit in midstretch and bested the others. ARRESTING OFFICER had good early speed and dueled between horses, was shuffled back a bit midway on the turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened. STONE HOT a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. URBAN HUNTER went up inside to duel for the lead, briefly put a head in front into the turn, fought back on the bend but weakened in the stretch.
