Footnotes

CHAPMAN'S PEAK stalked off the rail then outside a rival into the turn, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the turn, put a head in front between horses in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. LUCKARACK stalked outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch, battled outside the winner in the final sixteenth and went willingly to the wire. WALL DANCE pulled his way between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and edged a foe for third. KILLER BEAR between foes early, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. BATTI MAN (ARG) sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, fought back leaving the turn and in the stretch but weakened. RIVETING REASON hopped and brushed the side of the gate at the start, settled off the rail, angled in for the turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. RELENTLESS HEAT chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, continued between foes in the drive and could not offer the necessary response. LEGAL SEPARATION a bit slow into stride, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and weakened. IVANHO was in a good position stalking the pace outside or off the rail, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and also weakened.
