Footnotes

ALL FLAGS FLYING broke in stride then took just back off the pace from the extreme outside, moved up outside SMOKEY LADY to challenge for the lead into the stretch, drew clear quickly and continued to extend her advantage while not necessarily being asked for her best. SIZZLING SARAH raced unhurried early but always within striking distance, came two wide to the stretch, shifted out and rallied for the place without bothering the winner. ANOTHER VARIETY trailed early, saved ground on the turn then split horses at the furlong pole and was up for the show. NORTH BY SIX was permitted to settle early, raced four wide on the turn then failed to rally. GENERAL EXPRESSION stalked the pace from the rail, steadied inside the winner at the three eighths pole and gradually faded. GONE TO PARTY settled in mid pack early, raced three wide on the turn then lacked a solid closing response. SMOKEY LADY broke a step slow but was quickly in stride and made the lead early while crossing to the rail, maintained a short lead enter the lane but had little left.
