Footnotes

OUT GHOST broke slow then rushed up from the rail to reach contention early, angled around HIGH SIERRA POLICY on the turn and gained command a furlong out then edged clear driving. HIGH SIERRA POLICY set the pace from the inside to the furlong pole and slackened. SWEET CASS lacked good early speed, raced three wide on the turn and finished in a mild rally. FUNTRIP steadied in the opening strides to fall behind, raced four wide on the turn and did not rally. KICKIN FAST stalked the pace from the outside, crossed over to be nearer the rail leaving the half mile pole but had little left nearing the stretch. SWEETKINDYLYNN settled early, checked in tight quarters leaving the half mile pole but had no further response. LOVING CREEK was squeezed off the start then showed no early speed, dropped inside for the drive, was blocked at the furlong pole and lost any chance for a better placing. TURKISH SCOUT lacked early speed, raced five wide on the turn and failed to respond. YOUWANTMETOWHAT flashed speed to the turn and gave out. IPLANONBEBOPPIN settled early, was in tight at the half pole then faded steadily. The steward's posted the inquiry sign and reviewed KICKIN FAST'S trip on the backstretch but in a majority decision allowed the original finish to stand.
