Footnotes

GEE HONEY lacked good early speed while crossing over near the rail on the backstretch, commenced her bid two wide on the turn to rally into the stretch, shifted outside but just inside SHE MADE IT HAPPEN near the furlong pole then closed steadily once straightened and was up late to win driving. LOVE FEST stalked the pace three wide early, moved up once in the stretch, challenged for command leaving the furlong pole, made the lead late but could not stall the winner. SHE MADE IT HAPPEN was permitted to settle early, advanced four wide on the turn, then came on late without being a serious factor. JASMINE'S GEM was hustled to the lead to set all of the pace from off the rail to the furlong pole then slackened. MIRALOMA PARK stalked the pace from the inside to the stretch and weakened. OUR TORI raced close up from the rail to the turn and gave out. FIRST ALLIED had no speed in a dull effort.
