Footnotes

NORTH AMERICAN (BRZ) was unhurried to the half, came two wide to the stretch, shifted out for room, rallied and split rivals, was brushed by WASSERMAN in deep stretch but finished willingly and held off DIAMOND INDY. The latter was fanned four wide to the backstretch then settled to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch, shifted inward then had the rider drop his whip at the furlong marker but finished gamely under strong hand urging to just miss. CROWNED DANCER lunged from the gate at the start then settled to the half, came three then four wide to the stretch, rallied into a contending position to mid stretch but was outfinished to the line. THAMES set a pressured pace to the half, responded and edged away to the stretch, remained clear to mid stretch but was tiring in the final furlong. WASSERMAN stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, remained inside and rallied to mid stretch, loomed boldly a furlong out but was outfinished to the line. APOLLO KING had no speed and raced well off the rail to the half, got fanned out four wide on the far turn but was making up ground belatedly. DANCING PIONEER pressed the pace three wide to the second turn then came up empty when roused and gave out.
