KIRKWALL (GB) settled inside early and well off the lead, eased out once on the backstretch and advanced gradually, was forced four wide on the second turn, dropped in a bit once in the stretch, came through tight quarters at the furlong pole to take command and drew clear driving. KRAAL was never far back while unhurried, advanced four wide just in front of the winner on the second turn, offered his best bid at the furlong pole but could not match strides with the winner. LONG DRIVE stalked the leaders from the inside and was a bit rank leaving the half mile pole while behind traffic, saved ground on the second turn to loom a bold factor in the upper stretch, became blocked and was forced to steady just before the furlong pole, shifted out and continued his rally too late. WEST COAST WARRIOR dueled from the rail well into the stretch and gradually faded. STANTON HARCOURT was void of early speed, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. CRAFTY FRIEND dueled two wide into the stretch and slackened leaving the furlong pole. MANIZALES (FR) was never a factor and was eased but walked off. DREAMER stalked the leaders early, stopped, eased and walked off.
