BANKLESS was hustled early to take command then settled in the opening quarter, drew clear on the turn without need of urging, was put to a drive nearing the furlong pole and held. PRIZED BUY lacked early speed, advanced two wide on the turn and finished steadily. HOPEFUL AND FREE stalked the winner from the outside to the head of the lane and lacked a closing response. SOCIALLY SHANON settled early, saved ground and finished in a mild rally. ROYAL COSTUME passed tiring horses. FALSTAFFS CHARM saved ground to no avail. RAY'S DELIGHT stalked the pace from the rail and came up empty. JANA O was well positioned from the outside early, remained five wide on the turn and faded. WRAP 'ER IN ERMINE was outrun.
