M. BRASSY broke alertly and set an uncontested pace for a half, drew clear on the second turn but was tiring late and just held off TE QUERA MUCHO. The latter broke a step slow and was allowed to lag back for a half, rallied when put to a drive on the second turn, circled the field into the stretch and was gaining ground late. MY DOREEN HAJJI stalked the early pace for a half but weakened after six furlongs. HOBIE'S GLORY saved ground but lacked any punch in the drive. BEARKA stalked the pace from between horses and tired. NATIVE GOLD DIGGER was four wide while chasing the winner to the far turn and gave way.
