HIGH TECH FRIEND chased the pace three wide, rallied leaving the three eighths pole, had his bid turned back, responded gamely in mid stretch and closed late to inch clear. WEGOTOHAVEHARTE set the pace for a half, repulsed the winner's bid on the second turn, responded into the stretch but was tiring in the final sixteenth. BOLCHINA'S PRIZE was four wide while unhurried for a half, advanced three wide on the second turn, responded when set down and was making a mild run late. ALVO CERTO (BRZ) had no speed, advanced two wide to the stretch and found his best stride too late. ALERT AND READY pressed the pace for a half, dropped back on the second turn and finished evenly late. CARLACHO (ARG) was allowed to settle for a half and lacked the needed rally late. ADCAT had no speed and was not a factor.
