BOLD ROAR dueled for the lead to the turn, edged away to the stretch then was under steady urging while increasing the margin to the line. JETTAS TOOTIE ROLL was outrun to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then closed willingly and tagged CERO QUATRO for second on the line. CERO QUATRO broke alertly then was outprinted, chased the pace, was caught four wide to the stretch, did not bother the winner then was nailed on the wire for second. SENOR HAPPY prompted the pace to the turn, raced three wide then eased inside into the stretch but failed to mount a serious rally. REAL CHILL was allowed to settle, raced three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. O'MALI'S ANGEL had no speed and was outrun. POK LUCK was used early and dueled the winner, was outrun on the turn then stopped in the drive. IN SHIP SHAPE was sent along for speed and also dueled for the lead to the turn, fell back to the stretch then also stopped in the drive.
