Footnotes

MANTIKA set the pace from just off the rail to the half, drifted out a bit and brushed MARCO'S CHOICE into the second turn, responded to pressure to mid stretch and held under steady urging. WHITE MARK chased the pace to the half, made a bid two wide on the second turn, raced up to loom a factor to mid stretch then could not sustain the needed response. EMERALD SHAKE had no speed, saved ground throughout but did not threaten the top two. PEKING BOY tracked the leaders from the rail to the five eighths, moved up inside to get within a length of the winner at the half, remained inside on the second turn but gave way through the drive. MARCO'S CHOICE pressed the pace to the half, was brushed by the winner into the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch but also gave way. SUNSET KID had no speed and was not a factor. BLACK APPEAL tracked the pace to the backstretch, advanced widest to the half mile pole but gave out before going six furlongs. YODELER SWISS LASS was fanned four wide early, settled to the half but stopped after six furlongs.
