STAGE FEVER was allowed to settle to the turn, advanced two wide to the stretch, shifted inside and rallied to the front leaving the furlong grounds then drew clear under steady urging. PURPLE RIDER had no speed and was outrun to the turn, came three wide on the turn then shifted widest in the stretch while closing ground but was not a threat to the winner while grabbing second late. PULZARRS HALO chased the leader to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then lacked the needed late response. MEGANS CANDY was outrun to the turn, tried to rally two wide to the stretch but finished evenly. L. A. CHOCKLI sped quickly clear, held a sizable advantage to the stretch but gave out through the drive. PRECIOUS GEM was allowed to settle, attempted to rally three wide on the turn but came up empty in the lane. FAMOUS ROYALTY chased the pace from the rail to the stretch then weakened. VALUED ANNUITY was not a factor.
