GINSENG settled early, advanced between horses to force the issue into the backstretch, dueled with HARD ACK TO FOLLOW to the far turn, responded when challenged by her stablemate into the stretch, battled bravely in deep stretch and got the nod. LINDA LOVE was under patient rating for a half, angled out three wide to commence her rally on the far turn, rolled up to the leaders into the stretch, took a short lead in mid stretch, dug in gamely and just missed. UNBRIDLED STAR was unhurried for a half, had to go five wide while advancing on the second turn, was no threat to the top two but was along for the show. HARD ACK TO FOLLOW dueled on the pace to the far turn, dug in briefly nearing the quarter pole but weakened through the stretch. JOI'S FLAME had no speed and only passed tiring horses. NIJINSKY'S PASSION had no speed and was outrun. RAYELLE attended the pace to the half and faltered.
