KIJARA broke sharply and dueled outside BELLA RAGAZZA to the turn, drew clear into the stretch, extended her advantage to mid stretch then was fully extended to hold KENTUCKY STORM. KENTUCKY STORM racing with a nasal strip, was unhurried early, checked while blocked behind horses from the inside at the seven sixteenths, found room and remained inside to rally into the stretch, was blocked again behind BELLA RAGAZZA at the three sixteenths, shifted out abruptly nearing the the furlong pole, got clear and closed steadily. GOLD IS ON TIME raced unhurried early, came into the stretch two wide and between horses then came on late without being a serious factor. BELLA RAGAZZA racing with a nasal strip, raced up inside after the break to pressure the winner to mid turn then gradually slackened. FLYING MISSION racing with a nasal strip, stalked the leaders three wide to the stretch and faltered. TARA NINA broke a bit slow but rushed to contention from the rail, remained inside on the turn then checked off KENTUCKY STORM while tiring in the upper stretch. PLATINUM CAT racing with a nasal strip, broke alertly but quickly fell back and lacked a response while three wide on the turn. ANDOVEREND racing with a nasal strip, broke slow, raced four wide and did not rally.
