COOCOO WALK raced between rivals to the turn, was two wide to the quarter pole, angled out sharply for room into the stretch, rallied when set down and drew clear late under steady urging. PAT'S POWER lagged to the turn, circled five wide to the stretch and closed late for the place. ORLANDO SOLAR wearing a nasal strip, settled early, was four wide and closed on the leaders with a strong move to the stretch, took command a furlong out but faltered in the final sixteenth. TOP ROMAN dueled on the pace to the stretch but tired through the drive. KITTY MAC COOL broke a step slow and stalked the pace from the rail to the turn but lacked a closing response. PEARLS N LACE wearing a nasal strip, dueled on the pace to the top of the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. MAGGIE N SANDY chased the pace to the turn and stopped.
