DAWN'S DAY broke alertly and stalked the leaders from the outside in hand, moved up four wide on the turn, challenged for command in the upper stretch, gained command nearly the sixteenth pole and edged clear. SUMMER HAZE pressed the pace from off the rail, advanced to the lead three wide and inside the winner into the stretch but could not hold. JIMMY DA BRICK was never far back, was sent up inside SALT FLAT SPEED entering the lane to be challenging at the furlong pole then could not sustain his rally. SALT FLAT SPEED set the pace from off the rail to the head of the lane and weakened. MARK THE BENCH raced unhurried early, came two wide to the stretch but failed to rally. SPECIAL NEGOTIATOR lacked early speed, raced four wide on the turn and did not respond. FULL GLASS broke poorly and was always outrun. AVALANCHE flashed only brief early speed.
