WEHO unhurried to the half, advanced and closed the gap inside on the second turn, rallied when roused in upper stretch, forged to the front under hand urging and was ridden out to the wire. PASS THE TEST set a pressured pace to the half, edged away on the second turn, remained clear to the stretch, briefly resisted the winner in mid stretch but tired in the final furlong. BEAUX ARTES lagged behind the winner to the second turn, followed that one into the stretch and also closed the gap to mid stretch but lost her punch in the latter stages. BELL OF THE YEAR tracked the pace early, shifted outside the leaders on the backstretch, raced three wide to the stretch but gave way in the drive. DONEGAL LADY prompted the pace to the second turn, tired after six furlongs then ducked out in upper stretch and gave out through the lane.
