Footnotes

I'MONMYWAYHOME took back in the early stages and raced unhurried to the turn, rallied quickly from the rail into the lane, remained inside to gain command inside CRAYON RED in mid stretch and won driving. FANCY A BANJO took back from between horses nearing the turn, shifted out to rally four wide into the stretch, finished steadily but was outfinished by the winner. ASSESSMENT lagged well back to trail to the stretch, came to the extreme outside in the lane and finished full of run. WOODLAND BREEZE stalked the leaders from the outside early, moved up four wide into the stretch to be challenging for command leaving the furlong pole but slackened in the final eighth. CRAYON RED dueled from the rail into the stretch, drifted out nearing the furlong pole and bumped with BUDDEES ART, then shied and steadied sharply past mid stretch when the winner came through from the inside. BUDDEES ART broke a step slow but quickly emerged from between horses to be engaging for the lead in the opening quarter, dueled into the lane but gradually weakened after bumped with CRAYON RED. YAGOTKISSESFORPOPS stalked the pace three wide to the turn and came up empty. DRIVING CAT was in tight at the start and settled off the pace, saved ground to the stretch but had no response.
