Footnotes

BWANA BULL was not asked for speed in the early going while fanned three wide to the backstretch, set out after the leaders at the three eighths pole, came three wide to the stretch, responded leaving the furlong pole, collared FREEDSGOOD late and won driving. FREESGOOD stalked the pace four wide into the backstretch while under a snug hold, was permitted to advance three wide on the second turn, challenged at mid turn, took command drew clear in the upper stretch but could not hold the winner in the final stages. ZONING IN raced close up while angling outside COALINGA KID on the first turn then became rank and fell back steadily on the backstretch, was last at the three eighths pole, shifted outside to be three wide into the lane and finished steadily in a good try. COURT THE KING was permitted to trail in the early stages from the rail, moved off the rail once on the backstretch but remained last to the second turn, quickly circled rivals four wide and outside BWANA BULL into the stretch to loom a bold factor but lost his punch in the final furlong. CANDY'S BRO stalked the pace three wide early, moved to the lead between horses into the second turn but slackened thereafter. BRAVE SUN was permitted to settle early from the rail, tried to rally while two wide on the second turn but had little left. COALINGA KID bobbed at the break, recovered and rushed to the lead into the first turn while crossing to the rail, led to the second turn then gave way steadily.
