CROOKED RIVER never far back to the turn, rallied three wide to join the leaders into the stretch, inched away to mid stretch then was under steady pressure to the wire. LOCKITUP prompted the pace early then moved up inside to duel for the lead mid turn, could not stall the winner in upper stretch but was not threatened for the place. TOOTALLNOCALL was crowded by JAY AY at the start, had no speed, entered the turn three deep but dropped closer to the rail mid turn then was no threat to the top two while finishing steadily for the show. R W DUSTY'S GIRL had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. JAY AY broke out and crowded TOOTALLNOCALL at the start, hustled to the front, set the pace to the middle of the turn then was collared and tired through the stretch. DREAM OF LACEY prompted the pace to the turn but was four wide and stopped after a half mile. BEAMER BEE stalked the pace outside of DREAM OF LACEY, was five wide into the turn but stopped suddenly in the stretch then was eased but walked off.
