Footnotes

SKYRIDGE ECHO pressed the pace inside to the stretch, shifted out in upper stretch, drifted out and leaned on NATIVE GOLD DIGGER in mid stretch, bumped that rival again in deep stretch and held. NATIVE GOLD DIGGER was rated off the early pace, saved ground into the stretch, shifted out in upper stretch, was leaned on by the winner in mid stretch, drifted in and bumped that one again in deep stretch and just missed. A. V. A. TRICKS set the pace to the stretch, responded in upper stretch but gave way in the final sixteenth. YOUNG SARA was reserved early, raced three wide into the stretch and lacked any late response. IT'S VICTORIA chased the pace two wide to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ITS A GONE hopped slightly and was checked at the start and raced very wide. BELLA VILLA had brief speed and stopped.
