LOOMING LARGE had no speed and settled to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn, pushed up to duel for the lead leaving the furlong pole then drove clear in the final sixteenth. SMOKIN SCOOTER bumped with BRAT CAT at the start and had the best speed, was clear from rivals to the second turn, responded but was collared in mid stretch then was outfinished but held off TOO DARN HOT for the place. TOO DARN HOT was fractious and reared in the gate prior to the start, broke clean and chased SMOKIN SCOOTER to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch, took a short lead to mid stretch but hung in the final sixteenth. WHITE MARK had no speed and saved ground to the half, closed the gap to the second turn but could not sustain a late rally and finished evenly. BRAT CAT chased the leader three wide for six furlongs then lacked a late response. ATTABOY JUNIOR had no speed and was outrun. SLICK MOVER was not a factor.
