PIRATE'S CHARM set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and weakened. BUBBLE GUM ALLEY lacked good early speed, came two wide to the stretch and came on for the show without being a factor. SCARLET BEDONIA dueled from the outside to the quarter pole and gave out. MAMMA MIA lacked good early speed then saved ground to no avail. HOLY DEUCE had no speed.
