QUITE UNUSUAL was well placed behind the leader to the second turn, rallied two wide to get to terms into the stretch, inched clear to mid stretch then held on stubbornly late. STORM THE FIELD was settled to the half, advanced inside on the second turn, shifted outside of YORKVILLE KID in mid stretch, finished willingly but was held at bay by the winner. TIGER ON THE PROWL had no speed, commenced a bid into the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then finished willingly late. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE was also allowed to settle for a half mile, offered his best bid three wide to loom a factor on the second turn but could not sustain that rally and weakened. YORKVILLE KID was hustled early and slipped to a clear lead on the backstretch, led to the stretch, was overtaken into the stretch then tired through the drive. MOCITO tracked the pace to the half, was three wide on the second but had nothing to offer when roused in the stretch.
