MR. EXCESSIVE broke alertly but was outrun by KOOL COMIC in the opening quarter, advanced two wide on the turn, took command a furlong out, drew clear then just held. MAEKEN NOISE settled early, commenced his bid four wide on the turn and finished steadily. LEADER OF THE BAND broke a step slow then raced up inside to stalk the pace, was caught behind KOOL COMIC in the upper stretch, waited briefly, shifted around him leaving the furlong pole and finished steadily. KING NAZARIO lacked good early speed, came four wide to the stretch and finished with some speed. GORILLA MOUNTAIN was void of any early speed, raced outside BAGMAN on the turn and came on too late. KOOL COMIC was quickly in stride to gain a clear lead in the opening quarter while crossing to the rail but had little left once in the stretch. GONE SKIMMIN saved ground to no avail. MIZZTER BROADWAY stalked the pace to the turn then stopped while three wide. BAGMAN had no speed.
