### Footnotes

SEA TOPPER chased the leaders to the turn, raced two wide to the quarter pole then swung four wide into the stretch, responded when straightened, closed with a stout run and was up in the last jump by a whisker. HIGHLY QUICK dueled outside of FARGO'S LEGACY to mid turn, inched away from that one to mid stretch, was under vigorous pressure in the final sixteenth but could not hold off the winner. FARGO'S LEGACY was hustled along early and dueled from the rail to the stretch but tired in the final furlong. DENAESALILDEVIL tracked the leaders to the turn, rallied three wide to loom a factor into the stretch but gave out through the drive. GET THE MONEY was not a factor.
