BOXELDER stalked the pace three wide to the half, responded and joined the leaders three wide into the second turn, battled through a long drive, was clear late and held off AMAZIN BLUE in the late stages. AMAZIN BLUE was fanned four wide on the first turn, settled to the half, rallied two wide then shifted out for room into the stretch, was outrun by the winner to deep stretch but was closing the gap late. CAYAMBE dueled for the lead while slightly off the rail to the half, continued to contest the lead to the stretch but weakened through the final furlong. TAXI FLEET was a pace factor from the outset while three wide, responded when asked on the second turn, dueled to mid stretch but weakened in the late stages and finished on even terms for the show. RAGE TILL DAWN was off balance when the gate opened and broke slow, lagged to the stretch then finished evenly late. REGAL TIMES stalked the pace from the rail to the half, came two wide to the stretch but did not rally.
