Footnotes

BLUEGRASS HILL (IRE) was outrun early and saved ground to the half, shifted out and made a big run three wide on the second turn, engaged MILLER'S TURBO for the lead in mid stretch then pushed past that one and edged away. BERTRAND AT MR A'S tracked the pace to the half, saved ground to the stretch then was under steady urging through the drive and got up to nail MILLER'S TURBO for second. MILLER'S TURBO set the pace to the stretch, dug in and resisted the winner to deep stretch, was passed by that one late and got nailed on the line for the place. VIDEOGAME was fanned four wide into the first turn then eased back to the rail into the backstretch, trailed to the second turn, advanced three wide to the stretch then finished willingly to the line. ASSESSMENT had no speed for a half, was roused into the second turn, eased four wide into the stretch and finished steadily. SECURE RISK prompted the pace to the half, came two wide to the stretch but weakened in the lane. DRIVING CAT was rank and hard to place into the first turn, finally settled around the five eighths, was fanned four wide while trying to rally on the second turn then came up empty. TILLMAN'S IMAGE stalked the pace two wide to the second turn but gave way through the drive.
