Footnotes

GARDEN WHIMSY was fanned four wide on the first turn but pressed the pace to the backstretch, pulled the rider to draw alongside CLASS EDITION at the half, dueled for the lead to the stretch then was roused once straightened, responded to two cracks of the whip and drew away under only hand urging. JUSTE SMILE was outsprinted to the first turn, chased the pace to the half, bid two then three wide to the stretch then did not threaten the winner but was the best of the rest. CLASS EDITION was used early and showed speed while three wide to the backstretch, dueled when hooked by the winner to the stretch but weakened through the drive. PLEASURE FAIR ducked inward and knocked hard into TALEGA DE ORO at the start, ricocheted over and brushed with CLASS EDITION, pressed the pace three wide to the half, was caught four wide on the far turn and gave out in the stretch. TALEGA DE ORO was knocked hard by PLEASURE FAIR at the start and briefly dueled to the backstretch, was outrun and settled to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch and also gave out. ELA ELA was used early and was pace factor from the rail to the backstretch, was outrun to the second turn and stopped after six furlongs.
