Footnotes

GOLDEN CAPOTE was void of any early speed, commenced his bid from the rail on the turn and rallied into the stretch, came off the rail at the furlong pole, resumed his bid and was up late to win going away driving. CASCADIA'S STAR lagged well back to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch, angled widest for the drive and closed fastest. PULL AWAY settled early, moved up four wide on the turn, challenged for command at the furlong pole, edged clear briefly but could not hold the top two. STAR OF THE BAR was well placed early, raced two wide on the turn and failed to rally. PURE JUSTICE set the pace from the inside, led to the furlong pole then gave out. WE LOVE YA TOO was permitted to settle early, raced three wide in mid pack on the turn but had no response. REASON TO RECKON lacked good early speed, then raced three wide to the stretch and failed to rally. ULTIMATE QUEST prompted PURE JUSTICE from the outside to the head of the lane and stopped.
