Footnotes

FOLK ART raced between horses and boxed directly behind the leaders for much of the way, swung out three wide into the lane, responded to collar CROWDED ROOM near the sixteenth pole and edged away as clearly the best. CROWDED ROOM prompted the pace two wide from the outset, moved to challenge after a half mile, forged to the front in the upper stretch but proved no match for the winner late. DOLPHIN BAND tracked the pace inside the winner to the stretch then lacked the needed response. HER EMINENCE raced unhurried early from the rail, remained inside to the stretch and came on late but was not a serious factor. RED HAIR LADY set the pace from the inside to the stretch then gradually faded. WINTER RUNNER was not asked for speed early then lacked the needed response in the lane. SKY DREAMS stalked the pace four wide to the second turn and slackened. SAN MIGUEL BOY was rank early, raced wide on the second turn and was not persevered with in the lane when obviously beaten.
