ITALIAN WINE was a pace factor throughout outside of DEEP MISCHIEF, came three wide into the stretch, responded when roused in mid stretch, took the lead inside the sixteenth pole and edged away late. DEEP MISCHIEF was urged some early after a mildly sluggish start and set a pressured pace, was just off the rail into the stretch, responded to mid stretch but was tiring and could not stall the winner. JUNE LADY lunged slightly at the start, chased the top two to the turn, came two wide to the stretch and was closing steadily late. MISS MISBEHAVIN' had no speed, came two wide to the stretch and finished in a non-threatening rally.
