SUMMER LASS tracked the pace to the turn, bid three wide and took command into the stretch, was briefly clear to deep stretch then was under strong pressure to hold WESTERN VIEW safe. WESTERN VIEW had no speed, responded quickly once asked but was forced to circle four wide to the stretch, then was under steady urging and closed steadily to the line. HURRICANE ROSE broke slowly and raced unhurried to the turn, raced two wide and closed ground to mid stretch then could not sustain the needed rally. NLOTSABUTTER was allowed to settle to the turn, came two wide to the stretch but faded in the final sixteenth. ROUGH R. N. prompted the pace two wide to the stretch then weakened. DREAM BOLDLY pressed the pace from the rail to the stretch but tired in the drive. SLEW'S JEWEL set the pace to the turn, was caught by the winner into the stretch then was pulled up and eased leaving the furlong grounds but walked off after crossing the finish line.
