**Footnotes**

SHADOW JUSTICE broke alertly and prompted WEST FORTY from the rail, remained inside on the second turn and into the stretch to challenge that rival past the furlong pole and proved best driving. WEST FORTY set all of the pace from off the rail to mid stretch then was outfinished by the winner. INVESTIGATOR WUNNO settled early, saved ground on both turns and was gaining at the wire. ECHO MIKE was forwardly placed from off the rail and finished in a mild rally. TIME FOR NINE was void of early speed, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. DON'T SAY THAT was far back to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch and closed a gap. BAGMAN could not keep up and was eased in the stretch but walked off. BLESSEDBYTHEBEST saved ground throughout but was eased in the lane and walked off.
