GET OFF THE SUGAR pulled to the front into the first turn, edged away on the backstretch, raced in hand to the second turn, turned back SOCCER DAN to the stretch then won in handy fashion. BLACKTIE TONIGHT chased the winner to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch, could not put pressure on late but outfinished SOCCER DAN for the place. SOCCER DAN also chased the pace to the second turn, offered his best run at the three eighths, could not get by the winner and tired through the final furlong. KIT BALADA (BRZ) was forced out five wide on the first turn, lacked speed and settled to the second turn, was roused three deep but came up empty in the drive. MOB RULE had no speed and was not a factor. HE HAS IT ALL tracked the pace for a half mile but gave out after six furlongs. RUN LION RUN was rank and hard to place to the first turn then lugged out to the backstretch, fell far behind then was eased when hopelessly beaten in the stretch but walked off after crossing the finish line.
