Footnotes

TAKIN IT DEEP took back from the gate but was a bit rank from the rail into the first turn, settled once on the backstretch and lagged just inside STARTAC to the second turn, advanced inside horses to mid turn, swung around STOCKS ARE RISING at the quarter pole, then continued to respond in the lane to wear down the dueling leaders in the final stages and was up late driving. EARLY FLYER stalked the pace three wide early while in hand, was permitted to race up into the second turn to take a slim lead then dueled with SIRPA to the deep stretch, gradually bested that rival but could not stall the winner. SIRPA was forced four wide on the first turn while settling just off the leaders, advanced steadily while remaining out on the backstretch, challenged EARLY FLYER at the three eighths, alternated with that rival to the deep stretch and slackened between horses in the final stages. STARTAC lagged to the second turn, commenced his bid just outside the winner into the turn, came three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. STOCKS ARE RISING set the pace from the inside to the second turn and gave out. OTHERSIDEOTHEHILL settled early just outside SIRPA, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but had nothing to offer. WA DANCER prompted the pace two wide for a half mile, fell back on the second turn and stopped once in the stretch.
