PLEASURE FAIR was in front shortly after the break to set all the pace under fine rating, turned back TERRA FIRMA on the second turn and drew clear to win driving. TERRA FIRMA was never too far back after having her heels clipped into the first turn, offered her best bid two wide on the second turn then could not match strides with the winner but held well for the place. CRAFTY BABE raced unhurried from the rail early, remained inside to the second turn while advancing, swung two wide into the lane and finished steadily without gaining on the winner. MON ARMOUR stalked PLEASURE FAIR two wide for six furlongs and slackened. BONBELLE lagged early from the inside, swung four wide on the second turn to offer a brief bid to the stretch then lost her punch. HOLY R. N. raced within striking distance from the outside in the early going, tried to rally three wide and between horses on the second turn but came up empty. REFLECTED LITE was in tight into the first turn, clipped the heels of TERRA FIRMA and unseated her rider.
