STEELY LOOK was a step slow at the start but rushed to the lead in the early going, extended her advantage on the turn and into the stretch then held while being kept to her task. STRAWBERRY BANKS was permitted to settle early, came three wide to the stretch and finished steadily. PAPA'S LIL' DARLIN lacked good early speed, saved ground to the stretch, remained inside for the drive and finished with some speed. GRAMAR LOVE was forwardly placed to the stretch then had no response. TAHOE BAY was void of early speed, raced wide to the stretch and passed tiring horses. TESLA showed little. TORI'S SCALAWAG was never a threat. IDLE STORM prompted the winner for a half mile and stopped. JOANIE T. saved ground and stopped.
