Footnotes

ADREAMISBORN raced unhurried to the second turn, saved ground on the second turn, raced unimpeded inside to the stretch then rallied through the lane and was along in time. FOXLAIR got fanned four wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch, rallied when set down for the drive, closed determinedly but was outfinished by his stablemate. HIGH ALERT dueled for the lead from the rail to the second turn, responded to urging to mid stretch, dug in late but could not hold. SHEDABAD (IRE) had no speed, bid two wide to the stretch then could not sustain the needed late response. DOUBLE LIFE was knocked sideways by INDIO HELIX (ARG) inside on the first turn, recovered and stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn but weakened in the drive. GAMBLER'S MARK had no early speed, raced two wide throughout and lacked the needed late response. INDIO HELIX (ARG) was bumped and squeezed from between DOUBLE LIFE and ES SPECIAL on the first turn, took back then settled but was not a factor. GEARDOWN dueled for the lead outside of HIGH ALERT to the second turn, responded to the stretch but tired in the drive. ES SPECIAL bore in on the first turn bumping INDIO HELIX (ARG), settled to the second turn but had little to offer in the drive. BURST YOUR BUBBLE was not a factor. A steward's inquiry into the bumping incident on the first turn determined that ES SPECIAL did cause interference to INDIO HELIX (ARG) and DOUBLE LIFE but no change was made because the offending horse was beaten by both those rivals.
